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Introduction

This is a preliminary survey of information and plans undertaken by state agencies involved with the Alaska Coastal Management Program. Assembled by the Inter-Agency Regional Coastal Planning Team, the purposes of the survey are to:

- (1) provide the coastal districts background information, maps and studies to assist in their compilation of local district plans;
- (2) bring to the attention of district planners ongoing and proposed agency plans for consideration when preparing district plans and;
- (3) initiate a process for bringing together information and plans pertinent to coastal planning.

Although much of the information contained in this report is site-specific and would only be germane to one coastal district, it is included in the state-wide survey to show other districts what has been undertaken in other parts of the state and to give a broad, state-wide perspective to persons or agencies not involved with specific district coastal plans.

Subsequent updates will include federal plans and information to broaden the scope of coverage.

The ongoing and proposed plans section is listed according to subject matter; community planning, energy, transportation and renewable and non-renewable resources. If copies are needed, a contact office or person is listed as well as the cost, if any, of the document.

The information section is divided into six categories:

- (1) Plans and programs -
This section contains completed programs, projects and plans.
- (2) Renewable and nonrenewable resources -
Where possible, this section is sub-divided further by the subject.
- (3) Transportation
- (4) Economic development
- (5) Data and bibliographic surveys -
This section is arranged geographically.
- (6) Maps -
Although narrative summaries accompanied some maps, if the undertaking was predominantly a mapping exercise, it is included in this section (which is also arranged geographically.)

Alaska's Wildlife Management plans are the result of a long-term planning effort which first resulted in the development of the Alaska Game Management Policies in 1973. These plans are another step toward developing a program for wise husbandry of Alaska's wildlife resources and, basically, are recommendations to the public by the Department of Fish and Game for the management of all wildlife in the State. The Department staff compiled and reviewed existing information on the status, distribution, and uses of Alaskan wildlife populations. Current and projected land use patterns and natural resource potentials and developments are also considered.

Description:

Each regional booklet is arranged in two parts. Part I contains an explanation of the planning effort and how the public will participate in the development of the plans. Included is an explanation of the management goals upon which the recommendations are structured. In addition, Part I presents a brief discussion of wildlife management in Alaska, reviewing the formal structure of management, the biological bases for wildlife use, and the problems encountered in managing wildlife. Part II contains the individual species/area management recommendations. Each of the regional booklets corresponds to one of seven geographic regions of the state, depicted in the attached figure.
